

# Animal Shapes

Carefully cut out all the 2D shapes on the next page.

Using all the shapes, follow the instructions to create a giraffe on a separate piece of paper. Remember to be careful when using scissors – you might need an adult to help you.

## You Will Need:

- Scissors
- Glue
- Paper
- Colouring pens.

## How To Build Your Giraffe:

1. My head is made from an **equilateral triangle**.
2. Each of my ears are made from a **rhombus**.
3. Each of my horns are made from two small **rectangles**, topped with a small **circle**.
4. My neck is made from a tall **right-angled triangle**.
5. My body is made from a **trapezium**.
6. Each of my legs is made from an **isosceles triangle**.
7. My tail is made from a small **right-angled triangle**.
8. Now colour me in!

**Can you draw a different wild animal only using regular 2D shapes?**
