## Plastic, What Is The Problem?

We know plastic can harm wildlife and pollute our landscapes for decades if it is not disposed of properly, yet half of the plastic we consume, we use just once and throw away.

Sadly, unlike metal, plastics do not rust or corrode. They slowly break down into smaller and smaller fragments known as micro-plastics, so they aren't ever really gone!



## HOW YOU CAN HELP

### REDUCE

Use less or find an alternative

- Replace single-use face coverings with reusable fabric face coverings, and replace tinsel with homemade strings of popcorn, scraps of fabric or greenery from your garden.

### REUSE

If you can use an item more than once, please do!

### RECYCLE

Wherever possible, recycle unwanted plastic items

- Pass unwanted toys on to younger family members or friends to enjoy.

### FINALLY, AND MOST IMPORTANTLY, BE ACTIVE:

- Ask businesses to take responsibility for the packaging they create and find alternatives
- Ask governments to prioritise laws that protect our environment.
