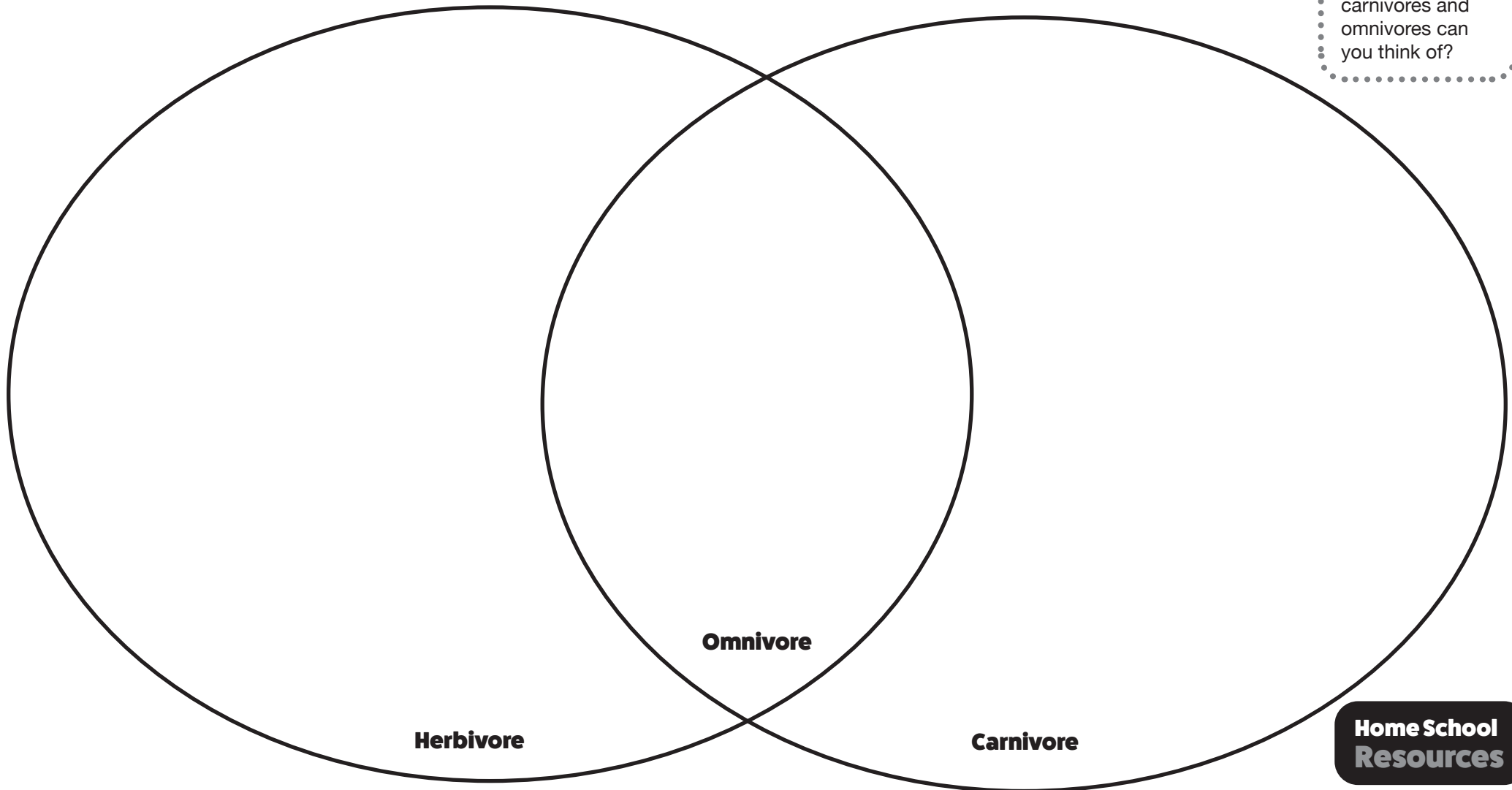
Can you add any more animals by drawing them into the correct section of the Venn diagram? How many different herbivores, carnivores and omnivores can you think of?

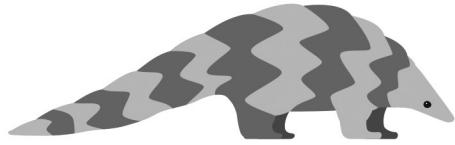
All animals need to eat food to have enough energy to grow and have babies. We class animals into three groups depending on what type of food they eat:

- **Omnivores** eat both plants and other animals.

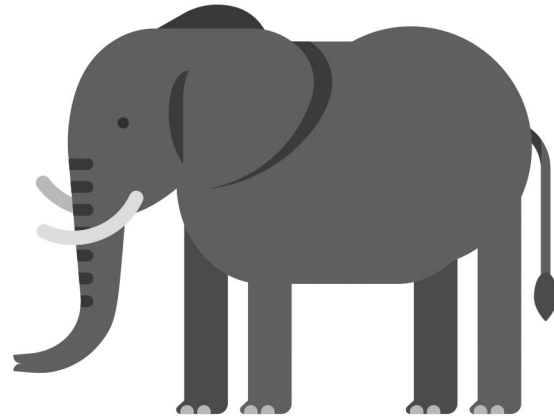
Your Task:

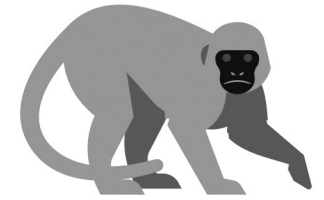
Pangolin
I eat termites and ants



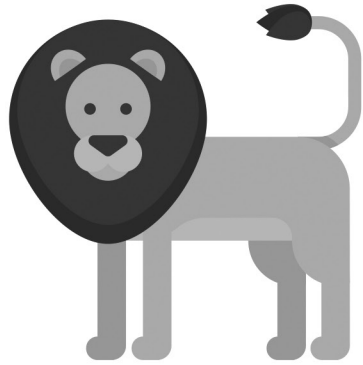
Elephant
I eat leaves, grass and bark



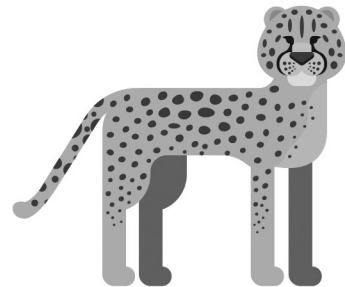
Spotted Hyena
I eat wildebeest and antelope



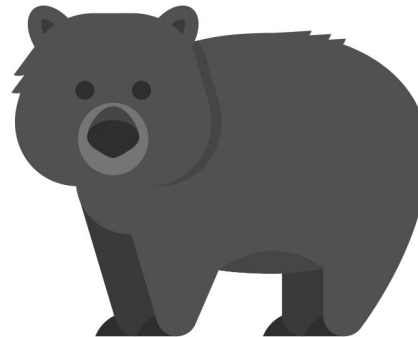
Vervet Monkey
I eat leaves, flowers and insects



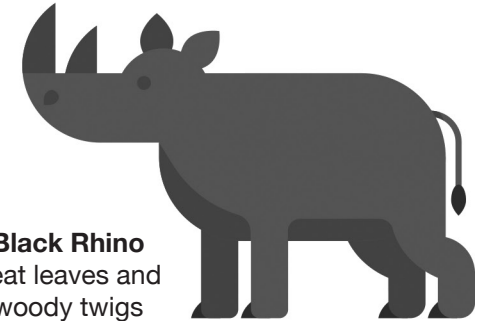
Lion
I eat antelopes and zebra



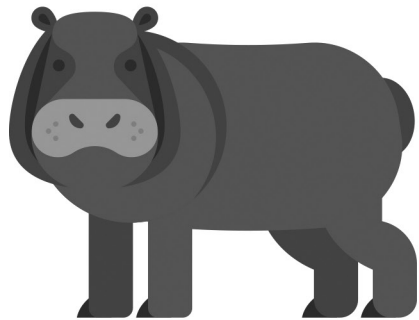
Cheetah

I eat leaves and woody twigs



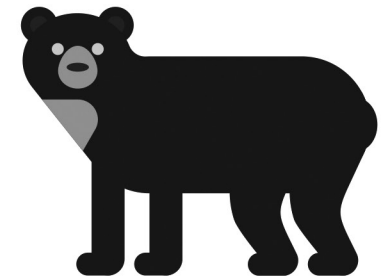
Hippo
I eat grass



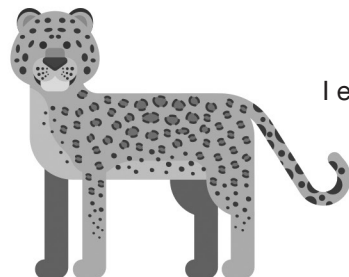
Orangutan
