All animals need to eat food to have enough energy to grow and have babies. We class animals into three groups depending on what type of food they eat:


- · Herbivores eat plants

Can you add any more animals by drawing them into the correct section of the Venn diagram? How many different herbivores, carnivores and omnivores can









